What we Should Know About Growth

1 Corinthians 3 verse 1-9

And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to men of flesh, as to infants in Christ. 2 I gave you milk to drink, not solid food; for you were not yet able to receive it. Indeed, even now you are not yet able, 3 for you are still fleshly. For since there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not fleshly, and are you not walking like mere men? 4 For when one says, "I am of Paul," and another, "I am of Apollos," are you not mere men? 5 What then is Apollos? And what is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, even as the Lord gave opportunity to each one. 6 I planted, Apollos watered, but God was causing the growth. 7 So then neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but God who causes the growth. 8 Now he who plants and he who waters are one; but each will receive his own reward according to his own labor. 9 For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, God's building.

Hebrews 6 verse 1-6

Therefore leaving the elementary teaching about the Christ, let us press on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of instruction about washings and laying on of hands, and the resurrection of the dead and eternal judgment. 3 And this we will do, if God permits.

John 15 verse 7-17

If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. 8 My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit, and so prove to be My disciples. 9 Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you; abide in My love. 10 If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love; just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love. 11 These things I have spoken to you so that My joy may be in you, and that your joy may be made full. 12 "This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you. 13 Greater love has no one than this, that one lay down his life for his friends. 14 You are My friends if you do what I command you. 15 No longer do I call you slaves, for the slave does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you.

- 3. Faith knowing how we are to persevere and to conquer
- 4. Ingredients for Kingdom Growth
- a) Seed God's word
- b) Soil Open hearts and minds
- c) Water Faith, which waters the words
- d) Sun The Fathers love, His warmth
- e) Weeding Removal of all our encumbrances

Luke 8 verse 4-15

When a large crowd was coming together, and those from the various cities were journeying to Him, He spoke by way of a parable: 5 "The sower went out to sow his seed; and as he sowed, some fell beside the road, and it was trampled under foot and the birds of the air ate it up. 6 Other seed fell on rocky soil, and as soon as it grew up, it withered away, because it had no moisture. 7 Other seed fell among the thorns; and the thorns grew up with it and choked it out. 8 Other seed fell into the good soil, and grew up, and produced a crop a hundred times as great." - 2. Failure to take God seriously
- 3. Failure to take satan seriously
- 4. Holding on to fixed ideals or traditions
- 5. Failure to discern Christs body (the church), being an island
- 6. Over emphasis on career or hobby
- 7. Over emphasis on doctrine, extremisms
- 8. Under emphasis of Christs teachings, replacing them with man's ideas
- 9. Breakdown of relationships, marital or fellowship
- 10. Insubmissive attitude to leadership, home, church, work, world
- 11. Lack of joy, usually coming from a failure to appreciate what Jesus has done and will do
- 12. Leading in legalistic doctrine without a servant heart
