God's Prophetic Word is all that He has planned and purposed from the beginning of time, today and forever; His written word is our instruction and His Son is our living example whose ways are also recorded in scripture. We are called to follow the leading and guidance of the Holy Spirit who is with us and in us for ever and ever. Amen.

God's Prophetic Word is revealed to us today by the Holy Spirit and has three parts to it:

- a) God's Word The Scriptures.
- b) God's Word Jesus, the Word became flesh.
- c) God's Word The spoken living Word manifested through the people of God, Jesus' true Disciples.

We shall look at five aspects of Kingdom life, discovering how we are wonderfully joined to God's plan from creation to revelation. When we have come to a place of realising our true identity according to His Word, we shall be more effective in the tasks that He calls us to perform. These five aspects are:

- 1. Revelation The Unveiling.
- 2. Vision The Seeing.
- 3. Strategy How to Get There.
- 4. Faith The Vehicle.
- 5. Fruit The Reward of Obedience.

The following are just a few scriptures that will help us in our studies, pray that the Holy Spirit brings to you some revelation as you read them. They are:

Genesis 1 verse 1-3

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2 The earth was formless and void, and darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was moving over the surface of the waters. 3 Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

Psalm 110 verse 1-4

The LORD says to my Lord: "Sit at My right hand until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet." 2 The LORD will stretch forth Your strong scepter from Zion, saying, "Rule in the midst of Your enemies." 3 Your people will volunteer freely in the day of Your power; In holy array, from the womb of the dawn, your youth are to You as the dew. 4 The LORD has sworn and will not change His mind, "You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek."

Isaiah 9 verse 1-7

But there will be no more gloom for her who was in anguish; in earlier times He treated the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali with contempt, but later on He shall make it glorious, by the way of the sea, on the other side of Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles. 2 The people who walk in darkness will see a great light; those who live in a dark land, the light will shine on them. 3 You shall multiply the nation, You shall increase their gladness; they will be glad in Your presence as with the gladness of harvest, as men rejoice when they divide the spoil. 4 For You shall break the yoke of their burden and the staff on their shoulders, the rod of their oppressor, as at the battle of Midian. 5 For every boot of the booted warrior in the battle tumult, and cloak rolled in blood, will be for burning, fuel for the fire. 6 For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; and the government will rest on His shoulders; and His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. 7 There will be no end to the increase of His government or of peace, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness from then on and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will accomplish this.

Daniel 9 verse 24-27

"Seventy weeks have been decreed for your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sin, to make atonement for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy and to anoint the most holy place. 25 So you are to know and discern that from the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince there will be seven weeks and sixty - two weeks; it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress. 26 Then after the sixty - two weeks the Messiah will be cut off and have nothing, and the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. And its end will come with a flood; even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined. 27 And he will make a firm covenant with the many for one week, but in the middle of the week he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering; and on the wing of abominations will come one who makes desolate, even until a complete destruction, one that is decreed, is poured out on the one who makes desolate."

Revelation 11 verse 15-17

Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever." 6 And the twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and worshiped God, 17 saying, "We give You thanks, O Lord God, the Almighty, who are and who were, because You have taken Your great power and have begun to reign.

Revelation 19 verse 6-10

Then I heard something like the voice of a great multitude and like the sound of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, saying, "Hallelujah! For the Lord our God, the Almighty, reigns.

7 Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride has made herself ready." 8 It was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright and clean; for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. 9 Then he said to me, "Write, 'Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb." And he said to me, "These are true words of God. 10 "Then I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "Do not do that; I am a fellow servant of yours and your brethren who hold the testimony of Jesus; worship God. For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."

We will find that there is a considerable amount of overlap in the five aspects, they are very much interrelated and interdependent, rather like the Word of God, also we will find that the Holy Spirit will open up for us new understanding, teach us things we have not experienced before as well as confirming and enlarging some of the things that we already know. The purpose of the Holy Spirit is to lead us into all truth, not just some of the truth, therefore we need revelation about the wrong understandings as well as the right ones and He will remove the wrong and replace them with the right. He will nor want our minds to be full of information, rather He will want to form new things of God in our hearts. The Holy Spirit is the same creative Spirit that created the heavens and the earth in the very beginning, He has not changed, but we may have to! There will also be a number of case studies from the Old and New Testaments, these will be seen to be relevant to the church today and it is likely that we may see the difference between God's plan and ours, the church throughout history has often steered their own course, we can do the same if we do not keep to His pathway.
